Snow, ie, moguls, jumps, snowmaking mounds, shear drop-offs, bare ground, rocks, roots, stumps, trees, lift towers, bumps, snowmaking equipment, grooming vehicles, snowmobiles, other skiers & snowboarders, power poles and other natural or man-made objects, and other conditions known & unknown are inherent risks of the sport. Falls or collision with natural or man-made obstacles can cause permanent injury or death, or property damage. Your safety is directly affected by your judgment. Failure to use good judgment while skiing and/or snowboarding may result in injury and/or death. Skiing and/or snowboarding can be enjoyed in many ways. Regardless of how you decide to enjoy the slopes, always show courtesy to others & be aware that there are elements of risk in the sport that common sense & personal awareness can help reduce.

Ez Ski Bus acts solely as an agent between the client and the mountain and cannot be held liable for any injury, loss and/or damage sustained during any ski trip. In addition, the parents/guardians of all skiers under the age of 18 and/or all others who participate in the ski trip are fully aware of the risks involved in this sport, therefore cannot hold Ez Ski Bus, its owners, employees, or agents, liable for any injury, loss, and/or damage sustained during this ski/snowboard trip. Skiing can be a great and safe experience. Ez Ski Bus stresses that all participants put safety and respect for the mountain first and foremost.

Please note: In the event of a medical emergency that requires off-site treatment:

- The bus cannot be held at the end of the day. The customer is responsible for transportation to or from any medical facilities
- Ambulance transport is the rider's responsibility. The bus may not be used to transport any injured rider.

In case of medical emergency, to a minor, on the ski/snowboard trip the Ez Ski Bus chaperone must be given the authority to have your child medically treated.
